4. TEREBRA AREOLATA. Pl. X. Fig. 23. Ter. testâ lanceolato-turritâ, gracili, anfractibus planis, longitudinaliter plicato-costatis, costis tumidiusculis, confertis, subundulatis, interstitiis alveolatis; rubellâ, albo variegatâ.

HAB. China Sea.

The opaque white marbling of the shell is mainly upon the ribs, which have a swollen appearance, and are unusually close-set.

Stat. 37. Sailus ketjil, Paternoster-islands. 27 M. and less. Coral and coralsand. 1 Spec.

Stat. 204. Between islands of Wowoni and Buton, Northern entrance of Buton-strait. 75—94 M. Sand with dead shells. 1 Spec.

Stat. 240. Banda. 9—45 M. Black sand, coral, Lithothamnion. 1 Spec.

The specimen from Stat. 204 is quite bleached and not perfectly identical in sculpture, so its determination is a little doubtful. Most monographers consider this shell as a synonym or slight variety of allied species, but DESHAYES considered it to be a valid species. The Siboga-specimens are in accordance with this view.

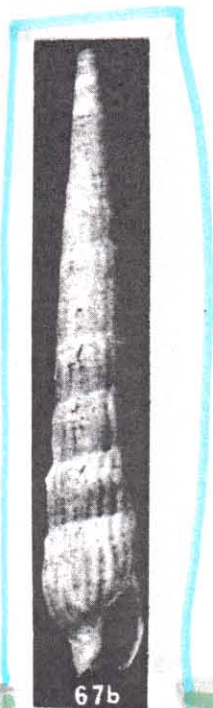

22. *areolata*, *Terebra* - ADAMS & REEVE, 1850, Voy. Samarang, p. 30, pl. 10, fig. 23 (non *Vertagus areolatus* LINK, 1807). Hab. China Seas ("Fiji Islands" on label). Size of figure: 36.0 mm. Three syntypes present, rather questionable ones at that, of which the largest measures 24.0 mm and is marked with x inside the aperture and near the apex of the shell on the tablet. These 3 specimens are the same species as *Terebra kilburni* R. D. BURCH. 1965. C69 p 212
