104. TEREBRA CHILENSIS, Desh.

T. testa elongato-subulata, castaneo-fusca, longitudinaliter tenuè plicata; unfractibus numerosis, convexiusculis, sulco lato impresso inaequaliter bipartitis; sutura marginata; margine angusto crenulato; ultimo anfractu elongato, attenuato, fasciola albidula, transversim bipartito; apertura ovato-angusta, utrinque attenuata; columella angusta, cylindræa, apice attenuata, canali angusto-emarginata; extus contorta.

Long. 42 mill., larg. 8.

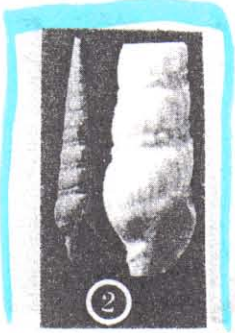

Terebra chilensis Deshayes, 1859, holotype, fig. 2. No figure previously published. Dimensions 40.2 x 7.9 mm. Original measurements 42 x 8 mm. Type locality Chile. This is a synonym of *T. gemmulata* Kiener, 1839, a rare species reported from Chile, Patagonia, and Brazil. BRATCHEE 77 VELUSI (2) 440

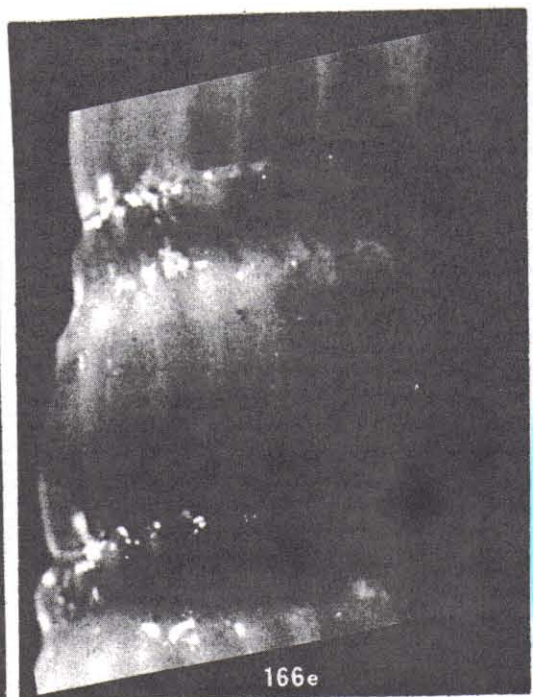
