Turbonilla (?) princeps, n. sp.

Pl. II, fig. 33.

Shell elongate fusiform, bright yellow, ornamented with a rich reddish-brown band just below the suture, and appearing on the body-whorl well below the periphery; whorls 10--11, flattened, very finely costate and bearing traces of microscopic spiral striae; suture scarcely impressed; aperture anniform; columella fold fairly well developed.

Alt. 3 millim.; diam. maj. 2.25. Aperture, alt. 1.5 millim.; diam. .75.
