T. testa elongato-angusta, apice acutissimo, alba vel flavidula, ad suturam fasciola fuscula, castaneo-punctata; anfractibus numerosis, planis, primis violaceo-lividis, longitudinaliter plicatis, plicis obliquis superne evanescentibus; ultimo anfractu apice attenuato, canali brevissimo terminato, basi late profundeque emarginato; apertura alba, ovato-angusta, utrinque attenuata; labro tenui, convexo; columella brevi, angulo acuto basi circumdata.

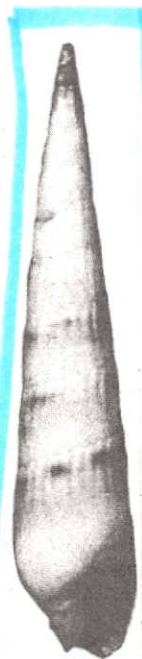

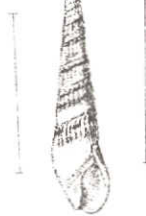

Species 136. (Mus. Cuming.)

TEREBRA APICINA. *Ter. testá aciculari, nitente-albá, infra suturas maculis rufis super fasciam livido-carneam cingulatá, anfractibus declivi-planatis, indivisis, superne elongatè plicato-crenulatis; aperturá parvâ, columellá appressè arcuatá, brevi.*

THE SHARP-POINTED TEREBRA. Shell acicular, shining-white, encircled below the sutures with red spots upon a livid-flesh band, whorls slopingly flattened, undivided, elongately plicately crenuled round the upper part; aperture small, columella appressly arched, short.

Hab. Singapore.

In this example of the same type the elongated crenules are larger, over a livid-flesh band, and a necklace of bright-red spots.
