100. **C. kirki**, *sp. nov.* Whorls flatish, smooth, polished, transversely plicated; body whorl small; mouth oval, columella smooth, straight; canal short, slightly bent to the left. Greyish black, greyish, or yellowish white, spirally banded near the mouth with purplish brown. Length, .8; breadth, .22; angle of spire, 18°.
