


5. TEREBRA ROSEATA. Pl. X. Fig. 24. Ter. testâ subulatâ, anfractibus plicato-costatis, costarum
interstitiis liris tenuibus clathratis, sulco prominulo infra suturas; pallidè roseâ.
HAB. Sooloo Islands; from sandy mud, at a depth of about thirty fathoms.
Of a uniform, delicate, transparent, pink colour.

TEREBRA ROSEATA. Ter. testâ obeso-aciculari, subcylindraceâ, eximie roseâ, anfractibus convexis, sulco pertuso
supernè divisis, undique densè plicato-costatis, inter-
stitiis lineari-sulcatis; aperturâ parvâ, suboblique con-
tractâ, columellâ laminatâ carinatâ, contorto-recurvâ.

THE ROSEATE TEREBRA. Shell stoutly acicular, some-
what cylindrical, delicate rose-colour, whorls convex,
divided at the upper part by a pricked groove,
closely plicately ribbed throughout, interstices linearly
grooved, aperture small, somewhat obliquely con-
tracted, columella laminated, keeled, twistedly re-
curved.

HAB. Sooloo Islands; Belcher.

Elaborately sculptured and uniformly tinted throughout
with a pure soft rose-colour.




Terebra roseata Adams & Reeve, 1850

Shell up to 25mm in length, very similar to *T. polygyrata* Deshayes, but differs in being larger, broader and less turreted. In mature specimens of *T. roseata* the columella is biplicate and the columellar callus-edge is risen above the body whorl surface. The species lacks the white sutural bands of *T. polygyrata* and is uniformly brown with a distinct pale mauve tinge, axial ribs are pale lilac in colour, protoconch brown; faded specimens are rose-coloured.

Moderately rare. Tropical Indo-Pacific; subtidal. *T. exigua* Deshayes, 1859, is a synonym. c70 p. 149
