Terebra unicolor, sp. nov.

Shell rather bluntly, elongately subulate, pale brownish orange throughout; remaining whorls 17, sculptured with a coarse infra-sutural spiral crenate rib and five smaller spiral crenate ribs, the interstices finely punctate; aperture small; columella recurved, twisted; canal short.

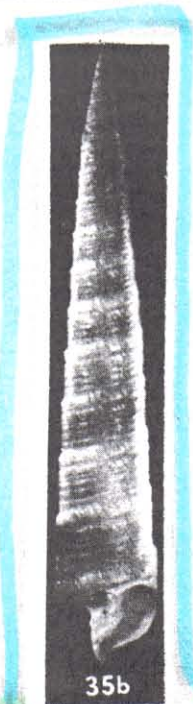

Allied to *T. albomarginata*, Desh., of which species I was at first inclined to consider it a variety, but its much blunter form, lack of white edging to the whorls, coarser ribbing and finer punctation
