

C. Carolinensis. Subulate; whirled with impressed spiral lines and numerous acute longitudinal ribs which are dislocated by a sulcus below the suture. Length, $2\frac{1}{4}$ inches. Resembles *C. dislocatum*, but is far larger, and has much more numerous and less prominent ribs.
