

*Terebra coxi* sp. nov.

(Pl. VII, fig. 10.)

Shell medium-sized, elongate; greater portion of the spire missing; sutural band occupying about a third of the whorl, and delimited by a shallow furrow; ornamentation consisting of heavy sigmoid axial ribs with equally wide or slightly narrower interspaces; aperture wide, elongate, anteriorly emarginate, with an angular canal at its posterior end; columellar lip with a shining layer of callus; siphonal fasciole low and uneven.

*Material*.—The holotype (an incomplete specimen). *Holotype*.—G.S.I. type No. 16470.

*Dimensions*.—Altitude 32 mm.; diameter 8.5 mm. (holotype).

*Remarks*.—As far as can be judged from the published figures, this species differs from *Terebra subtessellata* d'Orb., in having coarser sculpture and a more elongate aperture.
