The enthusiasm that I felt in dedicating a fine Dominican Miocene *Terebra* to Mr. Isaac Petit, American Consul at Monte Cristi, who proved such a kind and valuable friend to the Maury Expedition in 1916, caused me to overlook the recent *Terebra petiti* Kiener, named many years prior for the conchologist Petit. Therefore, I now change the name of the Dominican shell to *Terebra isaacpetiti*.

Locality.—Zone A, Rio Gurabo at Los Quemados.

Horizon.—Middle Miocene, Gurabo formation.
