*Gradaterebra* Cotton & Godfrey, 1932, S. Austr. Nat. 13 (2):  
66. Type species, *Terebra scalariformis* Cotton & Godfrey,  
1932, recent, Australia. "Tapering, narrow; axial ribs nu-  
merous, flexuous; protoconch blunt, two turns, smooth,  
round; last whorl cylindrically oblong, contracted at the  
base; columella slightly convex; anterior notch a little  
everted. Closely related to the genus *Euterebra* but distin-  
guished by the development of the axials and the convex  
whorls."
