

MICROTRYPETES

PILSBRY & LOWE 1932

This species is like *T. mariato* in having no subsutural fasciole. By the key to subgenera in Nautilus 37:51 it would come to *Acuminea*, which however differs radically in various characters. For this species and *T. mariato* we propose

MICROTRYPETES, new subgenus

type *T. iola*, characterized by having continuous ribs with no subsutural fasciole differentiated, and a weakly one-folded axis. Pilsbry & Lowe 1932 p. 43.

Microtrypetes Pilsbry & Lowe, 1932, Proc. Acad. Nat. Sci. Philadelphia, vol. 84: 43. Type species, *Terebra iola* Pilsbry & Lowe, 1932, recent, Eastern Pacific. "Axial ribs continuous; no subsutural band; one weak fold on the columella." Subgenus of *Terebra*.
