Genus: STRIOTEREBRUM Sacco, 1891

Type species: *Terebra basteroti* Nyst, [Helvetian]: original designation

Subgenus: PARTECOSTA subgen. nov.

Type species: *S. (P.) wilkinsi* sp. nov.

*Generic characters.* Shell terebriform; protoconch smooth initially, becoming ribbed later; early post-nuclear whorls knobbly, later whorls flatter and resembling those of *Hastula*; there is a circumsutural band with a limiting abapical groove.

*Partecosta* Dance & Eames, 1966, Proc. Malac. Soc. Lond. 37, pt. 1, p. 42. Type species, *Strioterebrum (Partecosta) wilkinsi* Dance & Eames, 1966 = *Terebra fuscobasis* E. A. Smith, 1877 recent, Persian Gulf. "Shell terebriform; protoconch smooth initially, becoming ribbed later; early post-nuclear whorls knobbly, later whorls flatter and resembling those of *Hastula*; there is a subsutural band and groove." Subgenus of *Strioterebrum*.
