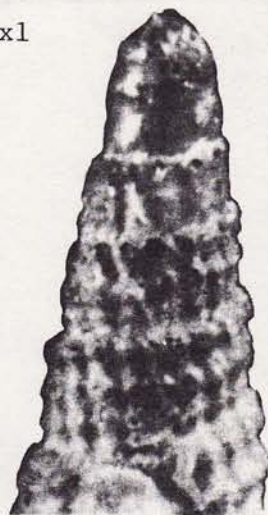

Reported from Mayagüez by Dall and Simpson. WALKER 1900 1901

n. FILE AUGER, *Terebra limatula*
var. *acrior* Dall, $\frac{3}{4}$ inch,
p. 133.

Shell small; white; deeply pitted;
with about $3\frac{1}{2}$ nuclear whorls; to
approx. 8 mm. Specimen illustrated
is the holotype (USNM 87294) from
100 fms. off Barbados.

GULF OF MEXICO-LOWER CARIBBEAN

Terebra (Acus) limatula acrior Dall, 1889, Bull. Mus. Comp.
Zool. Harvard 18 (2): 66. The type is lost and the descrip-
tion was too brief for identification. In 1901 Dall published
a figure of this species, but it was of a shell with most of the
body whorl missing. The figure somewhat resembles that
of *T. nassula* Dall. WALKER 1901 1902
