TEREBRA ARGUTA. T. parva, gracilis, turrita, ad apicem lanceolata, ex stramineo rubescens; anfr. 12+ convexis, plicis ad 20 eminentibus acutis, ad interspatia lineis volventibus impressis et posticè striâ profundâ incisis; ultimo anticè cancellato ad rostrum constricto: apertura perangusta, flexuosa; columellâ violaceâ. Axis 25; diam. 5 millim. Inhabits Porto Praya. W. S. Closely allied to *T. violascens*, Hinds, from New Guinea.

Terebra arguta Gould, 1860, Proc. Boston Soc. Nat. Hist. 7: 330. This species from the Cape Verde Islands is a primary homonym of *T. arguta* Gould, 1853, and at the same time is a *nomen dubium* since no type is extant and the species has not been illustrated.
