T. testa elongato-turrata, angusta, subulata, albo-flavidula; anfractibus numerosis, angustis, tenuiter transversim striatis, sulco impresso inaequaliter bipartitis, ultimo anfractu cylindraceo, basi attenuato; apertura elongato-angusta, subquadrata, margine acuto concavo; columella cylindracea, lata, contorta.
