T. testa turrilo-subulata, acuminata, pallide carnea, strigis longitudinalibus ferrugineis raris ornata; anfractibus planulatis, superne cingulatis, cingulo rotundato, confertim crenato, inferius lineis elevatis transversis 5—6, longitudinalibusque subarcuatis confertissimis decussato-granulatis; apertura oblonga, subquadrangula; columella nuda contorta, uniplicata; cauda abrupta. Long. 18—19''; diam. 5''.

Anfractus ultra 12, ultimus fere quintam totius longitudinis partem occupans, abrupte in caudam transiens. Cingulum elevatum, rotundatum, confertim crenatum circa quintam anfractus partem obtinet, et sulco satis lato a reliqua parte dividitur. Haec lineis elevatis transversis 5—6, longitudinalibusque confertissimis subarcuatis regulariter granulato-decussata est. Apertura oblonga fere quadrangula. Plica acuta a canali incipiente per mediam columellam decurrit. — A *T. tuberculosa*, *plicata* etc. sculptura facile distinguitur.
