T. testa turrato-subulata, solidula, eburnea, anfractibus planiusculis longitudinaliter distincte costulatis, sutura subcrenulata divisis, ultimo 2/3 totius testae adaequante.

Alt. 6 1/2 lin., diam. max. 2 lin.

Patria ignota.

Testa parvula, nitidissima, eburnea, subpellucens, pro statura parva solida. Anfractus 10 planiusculi concinne regulariterque costulati, in ultimo costulae 20 numerantur.
