2. EURYTA PULCHELLA, Ad. & Ang. (Pl. XXXVII. fig. 14.)

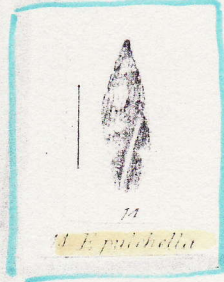
*E. testa oliviformi; spira quam apertura brevior; alba, nitida, lineis longitudinalibus undulatis confertis pallide fulvis ornata; anfractu ultimo fasciis tribus albis transversis instructo, anfractibus longitudinaliter plicatis, plicis parvis confertis, in anfractu ultimo obsolete, suturis crenatis; apertura angusta; labio subflexuoso; labro simplici, acuto.* (p. 119.)

Long. 5 lines, lat. 1 1/2 line.

*Hab.* Rapid Bay, South Australia (Coll. Angas.).

An oliviform glabrous species, delicately painted with pale fulvous zigzag markings.
